- Included is one free checked bag weighing up to 20kg / 44 lbs. and one piece of hand baggage weighing up to 7kg plus a slimline laptop bag or small handbag. For anything more, you can simply purchase extra bags online at a discounted rate or at the airport.

**Each passenger booked on an Airlink flight is entitled to a free baggage allowance of 20 kg in \*Economy Class and 30 kg in Business. Infants are permitted 10kg each, regardless of class of travel. Additional baggage allowance is available for purchase on \*\*most Airlink operated flights indicated by a "4Z" flight number. This additional baggage will be accommodated subject to space available in the hold of the aircraft.

Very important to note:

- Additional baggage purchases are valid per sector. Multiple Airlink sectors will require multiple purchases.
- Excess baggage charges for other Airlines or connecting flights needs to be paid directly to the Airline concerned.
- If you have purchased insufficient excess baggage on-line, additional excess baggage can be purchased at the applicable airport.
- No single item of checked baggage may exceed 32kg's (70lb).
- On-line excess baggage purchases are restricted to checked baggage only.
- All excess baggage purchases are non-refundable regardless of whether they are utilized or not.

## Safarilink

**Regional Flights and all other regional flights including but not limited to Coastal Air & Auric Air:**

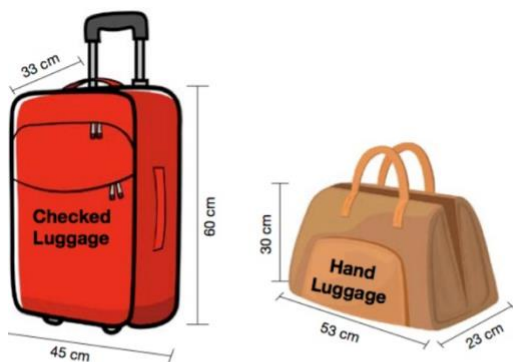
Baggage allowance is STRICTLY limited to 15 kgs. / 33 lbs. per person, except for Zanzibar, Kisumu, Kitale, Diani, Vipingo and Lodwar which is 20Kgs, inclusive of hand baggage and in soft bags.

- Infants not paying for a seat, are not entitled to baggage allowance. If passenger(s) have significant excess baggage, it is recommended to book a 'freight' seat at the child fare which provides the confirmed carriage of an extra 75kg of baggage.
- Excess baggage will only be carried, at the sole discretion of the captain of the aircraft, if the payload of the aircraft and/or space permits and will be charged at the prevailing rate for carriage of freight.

Note that bags are not tagged and checked-in like in large airlines: they remain always under the control of the customer who must not lose sight of them



*The best way to fly* Air Kenya's exclusive terminal at Wilson Airport guarantees swift and smooth baggage check-in.



#### Assistive Devices

- Wheelchairs, Canes, Walkers, Crutches and other assistive devices will be carried free of charge for qualified passengers with disability and are not included in the baggage allowance described. These items need to be collapsible. Baby car seat and foldable prams/ stroller will also be accepted.
- For other items e.g. sporting equipment, medical equipment, kindly liaise with our reservations team at the time of booking.



#### Carry On Baggage

- Personal items like handbags, small umbrellas, walking sticks, coats, small bag pack can be stored under the seat in front of passenger or in an overhead bin where applicable. These items must not exceed 5 Kgs/ 11lbs and are part of the baggage allowance of 15kgs/ 33lbs.

#### Excess/ Additional Luggage

- On Scheduled flights, to accommodate additional luggage, please book and pay for an additional freight seat in advance. The extra seat will allow for an additional 75kgs/165lbs excess luggage. Kindly contact Airkenya reservations to book. Please note that any additional luggage must still meet the baggage policy described above.
- If you wish to carry additional luggage on space availability, prevailing rate of USD 3+16% V.A. T will apply per kilo for local flights and USD 4 + 16% V.A.T for Kilimanjaro and Entebbe flights. This may not be an available option on the date of departure.
- On charter flights, should the aircraft not be filled to capacity and the guests wish to take additional luggage, please approach the charter department to make necessary arrangements.
- Complimentary **luggage storage facility** is offered for return flight' passengers who do not wish to take excess luggage with them.
- We also offer **soft sided bags** at our terminal at the passenger's cost.

**Note:** it remains the responsibility of the booking agent to inform their clients' of Airkenya baggage policy.



## BAGGAGE POLICY

Our exclusive terminal at Wilson Airport includes a swift baggage check in counter.

Due to the nature of our flights either on Schedule or Charter, our aircrafts are small in size and therefore have

much smaller luggage holds than most of typical airlines. We kindly request that our clients adhere to the rules and regulations regarding our baggage limitation.

### Checked baggage

- On all services, the maximum luggage weight is 15 kgs /33lbs in soft sided bags.
- As a guideline, standard **checked luggage** should have the three dimensions of 24 inches (60cm) height, by 18 inches (45cm) length and 13 inches (33cm) width.
- For **hand luggage**, 12 inches (30cm) height, by 21 inches (53cm) length, by 9 inches (23cm) width.



All aircrafts are small in size, they have smaller luggage holds compared to the larger international airlines. Therefore, kindly adhere to the following rules and regulations regarding our baggage dimensions and weight:

4. **Safari contract** to be filled out and signed. Please take a picture of the first and last page with your phone and email back. Make sure to include **APPENDIX C / Indemnity** for **each** person going on the safari.
5. **Guest information document** for each person going on the safari to be filled out and emailed back.

## PASSPORTS

1. Please email copies of your passports. Please be sure to check that your passports are valid for at least 6 months after your return to the USA after your safari. If this is not the case, please apply for a new passport and send it to me once you have received it.
