KENYA VISAS & VACCINATIONS

- Please be sure to get your Yellow fever vaccination and be ready to show proof thereof and entry will be denied if you do not have it.
- Please refer to the **TRAVEL INFO** document above for all the info
- The following is a guideline to the country you will be visiting. Further information is available to you on the official Kenya Tourism Authority's website at www.tourism.go.ke.
- All visitors to Kenya must have a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond their intended departure date from Kenya. Visitors must also ensure they have enough blank pages in their passports, bearing in mind they may be visiting several different countries and that certain countries, such as South Africa, often utilize the entire page for their visa stamps.
- The Government of Kenya has fully automated the issuance of their visa with effect January 1, 2021. In this regard, all passengers travelling to Kenya from countries that require visas to enter (both US and Canadian citizens do) shall be required to apply and obtain an e-visa before boarding an aircraft, as no visas will be issued on arrival. The e-visa can be obtained through <http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html>
- In the process of applying for your visa, more details will be provided as well as an invitation letter.
