PASSPORTS:

- Please make sure your passport is valid for at **least 6 months** beyond your date of country exit
- Passport **MUST** have **AL LEAST** have **(3) blank “VISAS pages” – the word “VISAS” must appear at the top of the page to be considered a “Visas Page” AS WELL AS at least 4 additional BLANK PAGES.** Airlines will refuse board if you do not meet this requirement.
