## **ACTION ITEMS**

#### 1. VISAS:

- o No visa's required for USA citizens travelling to South Africa and Botswana
- A Visa is required to enter Namibia & Zimbabwe, but this must be bought at the Port of Entry Approx US \$100 per person for Namibia (Payable with Visa or Mastercard) and US\$ 50 cash per person for Zimbabwe
- Visas are requited for Kenta, Tanzania & Uganda and must be obtained on-line and prior to travel

#### 2. PASSPORTS:

- o Please email a copy of your passports (take pic with camera phone).
- Please be sure to check that your passports are valid for at least 6 months after your return to the USA after your safari. If this is not the case, please apply for a new passport and send it to me once you have received it.
- o Also take note of the required empty visa pages <u>click for more info</u>

#### 3. VACCINATIONS:

- Prophylactic Malaria medicine is recommended for Zimbabwe, Botswana, Kenya, Tanzania & Uganda
- o No mandatory vaccinations required for South Africa, Namibia, Botswana & Zimbabwe.
- o Yellow fever vaccination or a waiver letter is required for Kenya, Tanzania & Uganda

#### Dimensions of Hand Baggage

The size of one carry on item shall not exceed the overall dimensions of 115cm.

#### SIZE & WEIGHT OF CHECKED-IN BAGGAGE

The maximum dimensions of any one piece of baggage permitted where travel is wholly on the services of Airlink flights are:

(H) 90cm + (W) 72cm + (L) 45cm (including handle, wheels and pockets) total dimensions 207cm

Dimensions of Hold baggage:

#### HAND & CABIN BAGGAGE

In addition to the checked baggage allowance, each passenger may carry without additional charges hand baggage suitable for placement in the closed overhead rack or under the passenger's seat with maximum dimensions specified by the carrier subject to space availability. Maximum dimensions for one piece are (H) 56cm + (W) 36cm + (L) 23cm and maximum weight 8kg. The size of one carry on item shall not exceed the overall dimensions of 115cm.

The standard allowance per class for domestic and international flights is:

**Business Class:** 2 Pieces plus 1 slimline laptop bag **Economy Class:** 1 Piece plus 1 slimline laptop bag

Unisex handbags are considered part of a passenger's wardrobe and not as hand baggage.
