1. VISAS:

- a. Please be sure to apply for your KENYA & TANZANIA visa's ahead of time. A Invitation letter will be supplied in due course.
- b. You will need proof of Yellow fever vaccination during the application process, so best to get it done as soon as possible

2. VACCINATIONS:

- a. Remember that Kenya requires a proof of Yellow Fever vaccination, and it must be administered at least 10 days before entering Kenya

3. PASSPORTS:

- a. Please email copies of your passports. Please be sure to check that your passports are valid for at least 6 months after your return to the USA after your safari. If this is not the case, please apply for a new passport and send it to me once you have received it.

HEALTH

3. Kenya, Tanzania & Uganda:
 - will require proof of **YELLOW FEVER** vaccination (must be taken at least 10 days prior to arrival) and you must bring proof of vaccination with you.
 - Please remember to bring anti-itch ointment & Deet spray at Tsetse flies present
4. Typically, Southern Africa countries like South Africa, Botswana, Zimbabwe & Namibia does not have any required vaccinations.
5. Malaria prophylactic medicine is advised when visiting Botswana, Zimbabwe & Zambia.

Airlines will refuse board if you do not meet this requirement.
