



SIZE & WEIGHT OF HAND-BAGGAGE



Dimensions of Hand Baggage The size of one carry on item shall not exceed the overall dimensions of 115cm.

HAND & CABIN BAGGAGE

In addition to the checked baggage allowance, each passenger may carry without additional charges hand baggage suitable for placement in the closed overhead rack or under the passenger's seat with maximum dimensions specified by the carrier subject to space availability. Maximum dimensions for one piece are (H) 56cm + (W) 36 cm + (L) 23cm and maximum weight 8kg. The size of one carry on item shall not exceed the overall dimensions of 115cm.

The standard allowance per class for domestic and international flights is:

Business Class: 2 Pieces plus 1 slimline laptop bag Economy Class: 1 Piece plus 1 slimline laptop bag

Unisex handbags are considered part of a passenger's wardrobe and not as hand baggage.



SIZE & WEIGHT OF CHECKED-IN BAGGAGE

The maximum dimensions of any one piece of baggage permitted where travel is wholly on the services of Airlink flights are:

(H) 90cm + (W) 72cm + (L) 45cm (including handle, wheels and pockets) total dimensions 207cm

Please make sure your checked bags are within the dimensions outlined in the diagram. Bags greater than the dimensions provided are too large for airport conveyor belts and will not be accepted on the flight.

Baggage Policy

Our exclusive terminal at Wilson Airport guarantees swift and smooth baggage check-in. As all our aircraft are small in size, they have smaller luggage holds compared to the larger international airlines. We, therefore, kindly request that our clients adhere to the following rules and regulations regarding our baggage dimensions and weight:

Checked baggage

- On all services, the maximum luggage weight is 15 kgs /33lbs in soft-sided bags.
- As a guideline, standard checked luggage should have the three dimensions of 24 inches (60cm) height, by 18 inches (45cm) length and 13 inches (33cm) width.
- For hand luggage, 12 inches (30cm) height, by 21 inches (53cm) length, by 9 inches (23cm) width.

Carry On Baggage

• Personal items like handbags, small umbrellas, walking sticks, coats, a small backpack can be stored under the seat in front of passengers or in an overhead bin where applicable. These items must not exceed 5kgs/11lbs and are part of the baggage allowance of 15kgs/33lbs.

Excess/ Additional Luggage

- For scheduled flights, passengers can book and pay in advance for an additional freight seat to carry up to 75kgs/165lbs excess luggage that must still meet our baggage policy.
- Excess baggage is charged at USD 5 per kilo for both domestic and international routes. This may not be an available option on the date of departure.
- For charter passengers, additional luggage can be arranged as long as the aircraft is not filled to capacity.
- A complimentary luggage storage facility is offered for return flight' passengers who do not wish to take excess luggage with them.
- We also offer soft-sided bags at our terminal at the passenger's cost.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE: RESERVATION CONFIRMATION

1. Passengers must hold a ticket in order to board a flight. All air carriage is subject to the rules and limitations relating to liability established by the Warsaw Convention and/or Montreal Convention 1999.

2. Each passenger is allowed 15 kgs of personal baggage. This allowance shall include all hand baggage. Soft bags are a requirement. The Company does not accept liability for any valuables including any cash, credit card, jewellery, cameras, computers etc. contained in checked baggage.

- All baggage checked in is tagged and loaded by the airline, but on disembarking the passenger must ensure he/she has all their bags.
- Excess Baggage: The carriage of excess baggage is at the sole discretion of the Captain, after taking into consideration the aircraft being used, and the number of passengers booked. When excess baggage is carried it will be charged at the prevailing freight rate.
- In the event of the baggage or freight being lost or damaged during carriage, then the Company's liability is limited to a maximum of US\$10 per kg. All claims for such events must be made in writing within 7 days of their occurrence. All unaccompanied baggage must be open for inspection at check-in.



SAFARI AIR LINK Click for Safari Air baggage restrictions

- Maximum luggage allowance including handbags and camera equipment is restricted to 20kgs/44lbs per person in soft-sided luggage which may have one rigid side.
- No hard suitcases or bags with frames can be transported.
- Maximum dimensions of soft bags are 25cm/10in wide by 30cm/12in high and 65cm/26in long.
- There may be up to 3 stops en-route to/from camps.



Click for Auric Air baggage restrictions

- The total baggage allowance for each passenger, inclusive of hand baggage, cameras, filming equipment and any other personal item including loose clothing, is 20kgs (44lbs) per passenger.
- Excess baggage will only be carried, at the sole discretion of the Captain of the aircraft, if the payload of the aircraft and/or space permits and will be charged at the prevailing rate for carriage of freight.
- If passengers anticipate they will have excess baggage, we recommend the below options:
- Excess Baggage is available in slabs of 10kgs.
- Excess baggage cost: \$60.00 & \$30.00 per slab
- Cost varies on the route/class booked.
- Maximum 4 slabs (40kgs) of additional luggage can be booked per passenger.
- Excess baggage can be purchased online for all classes on all routes.
- For more than 40kgs, a "freight" seat at a child fare to be booked, which will permit confirmed carriage of an extra 75kgs. Captain of the aircraft may weigh the bags at airstrips, excess baggage can only be allowed at the Captain's sole decision based on aircraft's capacity. We accept suitcases, as long as they are within the size limit.
- Freight is strictly carried at the sole discretion of the Captain of the aircraft. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure any freight, In the event the freight being lost or damaged during carriage, the Warsaw convention states that the Company's liability is limited to a maximum of US \$20 per kg. Damaged baggage will be considered on an individual basis depending on the extent of the damage. Scratches or opened zips will not be considered.



Click for MackAir baggage restrictions

- Maximum luggage allowance including handbags and camera equipment is 20kgs/44lbs per person in soft bags with no rigid frames.
- Checked luggage mustn't exceed 30cm/12in wide x 35cm/14in high x 70cm/28in long.
- Passengers weighing over 115kg/253lbs may have to purchase an extra seat, please inform us prior to travel.
- Operating as a shuttle service flight times and routes vary and, although unlikely, there may be up to 4 stops en-route to/from camps





Click for FlySafair baggage restrictions

- Your fare comes with one free carry-on bag. Your carry-on bag should not weigh more than 7kg and must fit in the storage compartment in the cabin. The dimensions should not exceed 56cm x 36cm x 23cm.
- Checked-in luggage can be purchased separately. Should you wish to add a 20kg bag to your flight, this can be selected on our Extra's page during the online flight booking process for R155. Alternatively, you can purchase a ticket for your bag through the call centre, or at the airport when you check-in for R350. For clarity, only one piece is allowed.

- Customers who need a little extra luggage are welcome to purchase an extra 20kg suitcase subject to a R250 charge either when booking tickets online or after booking using our Manage Booking portal. Adding another bag at the airport will cost R250.
- Note: Only available if you already have checked-luggage in your basket or on your booking.
- In addition, you may also bring one personal item, either a slimline laptop bag or a handbag, but not both. This personal item should not exceed 40cm x 15cm x 20cm and must fit under the seat in front of you.



 Most airlines allow passengers to take either 20kg or 23kg per person in checked luggage (this is the bag that goes in the hold of the aircraft). Usually, you're only allowed to carry this in 1 piece of luggage. The average maximum dimensions for checked baggage are 90cm x 75cm x 43cm.



Checked Luggage

The Baggage Allowance on ALL routes is 21kgs (checked, this includes SkyCheck Luggage) and 7kg Carry-on Where excess baggage, or an additional baggage allocation is purchased, no single bag weighing over 32kg will be accepted and must be shipped separately as cargo.

Air Botswana operates an all economy cabin and allows per passenger, 23kg checked luggage. Infants not occupying a seat are entitled to a free luggage allowance of 10kg. Air Botswana also accepts only one piece of hand luggage of not more than 7 kg.
