2. VACCINATIONS:

a. Prophylactic Malaria medicine is recommended for Zimbabwe & Botswana

b. No mandatory vaccinations required for South Africa, Namibia, Botswana & Zimbabwe

3. PASSPORTS:

- a. Please be sure to check that your passports are valid for at least 6 months after your return to the USA after your safari. If this is not the case, please apply for a new passport and send it to me once you have received it.
